Invoice of sundry articles provided by Friends of Pennsylvania &c and sent to the Treaty expected to be held with the Indians Nations by General Wayne to be by him presented to them, at such time as he may see most convenient and proper, as a token of good will and to revive in the remembrance of the Indian Nations of this Land the ancient Friendship which subsisted between them & the people called Quakers
